

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

- > Students are involved in Peer Group Teaching. Students make presentation to their class mates. Such activities help to develop confidence and skill of public speaking among students.





• Seminars/ Special Lectures organized by the Department of Sociology

On 1st October 2008, the Department of Sociology organized a seminar on 'Changing Status of Women'. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Deboprasad Chatterjee, Head of the Department of Sociology, Maulana Azad College. Dr. Chatterjee discussed the role of women in ancient and medieval period. He compared the role of women in present times with that of the past. He discussed problems women confronted at workplace in contemporary times.

▶ 13th September 2013 was an eventful day not only in our college, but throughout India. On that day the Saket Court pronounced death penalty to all the accused in the famous Delhi Gang Rape of December 16, 2012 popularly known as Nirbhaya case. Two weeks ago, i.e. during the last week of August, 2013, the Juvenile Justice Board had pronounced its verdict on the juvenile involved in that case. We, the Department of Sociology organized a Special Lecture on 'Juvenile in Conflict with Law' on 13th September 2013. The Special Lecture was delivered by Dr. Bipasha Roy, Member, Juvenile Justice Board, Kolkata District. She spoke of her varied experiences when such cases are brought before the Juvenile Justice Board. She spoke of the weaknesses of the Juvenile Justice Care & Protection Act (henceforth JJ Act), 2000, and 2006 (amended).

The Department of Sociology organized a field trip at Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Complex on 16th November 2013. Sixteen Honours students (16) from both first and second year along with two teachers of the department namely Dr.Tumpa Mukherjee and Smt. Tulika Bhattacharyya visited the house where Swami Vivekananda was born on 12th January 1863. In the beginning a short documentary on the childhood days of Swami Vivekananda was shown. It was followed by a visit to the original ancestral house where the Dutta family lived.






